Why Study Abroad?

- Life-changing academic enrichment, personal growth, professional independence
- Cultural immersion, expanded global awareness, cross-cultural communication

What is Our Program?

- Specialized 3-week program, “Global Perspectives of Public Health and Food Security”
- Cultural Awareness (CA) for the TCU Core and/or upper-level elective
- Active participation in several community engagement and service-learning activities
- Interprofessional collaboration with students, faculty, experts, and local citizens
- Majority of learning takes place outside the classroom with minimal lectures
- Exploration of culture through foodways, cuisine, arts, sports, history, daily living
- Students are housed in private rooms with kitchenette and bathroom; faculty in same building

Who is Eligible?

- Open to all students; preference to students majoring in Nutritional Sciences or Nursing
- Maximum 25 students
- Fluency in Spanish is not required

What are the Costs?

- Tuition (3-credit hour undergraduate) – \$6,945 (\$2315 per 1 credit hour estimated for Summer 2027)
- Program fee – approximately \$4,500; includes all program activities, housing, a few meals
- Transportation to Seville –
 - Average roundtrip airfare during the past year DFW to SVQ was \$1300 (at least one stop)
 - Some students choose to fly to Madrid and take train from Madrid to Seville.
- Additional costs include food (groceries and eating out), souvenirs, free-time activities
 - One student from 2025 stated these costs totaled about \$1500.
 - Another student from 2025 spent less than \$1000 total for the three weeks.

Are Scholarships Available?

- Yes! Many of them. TCU Global is generous with financial support for summer programs.
- There are need-based scholarships and merit-based scholarships.
- All students are encouraged to apply for financial aid.
