

Shooting Event Info – Saturday June 27th

*****All Participants are responsible for bringing a shotgun and shells*****

5-STAND Sporting Clay Competition - \$20 entry, 25 birds. Traditional 5-STAND menu thrown which will include 1 single, 1 report pair, and 1 true pair at each of the five stands. Maximum score is 25 and Top 5 scores & ties advance to the 5-STAND Shoot -Off starting at 4:00pm. **Bring your twenty-dollar bills!** Unlimited entries are accepted to raise the pot and increase your score. **\$20 entries create a 1st place CASH PRIZE.**

Wobble Wagon Fun - A two stand elevated shooting platform designed for your enjoyment. Each shooter will have the option of a manual mode or a 5-bird menu per stand. You are limited to **ONLY** 10 birds at time. This ensures that every participant has a chance to shoot. You are more than welcome to shoot as many rounds as you'd like. ALL PRACTICE BIRDS will be thrown from the Wobble Wagon.

Amenities - Upon arrival you will be greeted by the delicious smell of Danny's BBQ. Please dig in! The main lodge features both a pool table and a shuffleboard table for everyone to enjoy. There will be porta johns located on the premises including one bathroom inside the main lodge. Drinks, food, and beverages will be available to all who arrive at the Ranch. If you happen to run out of shotgun shells the Ranch will have ammo available for purchase.

Arrival NOTICE - Upon arrival every arriving guest/participant is required to have signed and completed the Ranch's liability waiver. We will try and provide the waiver to be signed in advance before the event date. If you do not possess a signed waiver, then you will simply be asked to leave. A check-in tent will be available for all arriving guests and participants.

5-Stand Safety Protocol

1. All guns will be handled with actions open and muzzles up, or in a safe direction.
2. Guns must be open and empty at all times, unless the muzzle is through a designated shooting station.
3. No more than two (2) shells may be loaded at any time.
4. Mandatory eye and ear protection required for all shooters and spectators.
5. Shotguns of 12 gauge or smaller, in safe working order, are permissible.
6. Ammo may not exceed 1 1/8 oz. lead and the shot must be 7 1/2, or smaller.
7. Any shotguns transported in a cart or utility vehicle must be stored in the vertical position.
8. The consumption of alcohol during the shooting event is strictly prohibited.
9. Please report any unsafe shooting condition immediately to Shoot Officials.

Awards and Prizes

Your aim will determine whether you take home cash and a 12-gauge Browning Cynergy CX over-under shotgun, or whether you just clap for the person who does. Each \$20 entry into the 5-stand competition will be added to the cash pool/prize. Champion and reserved champion will receive a handmade belt buckle forged by Clay Vigil. Second and third place will receive a yeti cooler. You will also have a chance to win a Springfield 2020 Waypoint Bolt 6.5 CM equipped with a Vortex Viper PST Gen II scope. **(POKER CHIP DRAWING ONLY)** Poker chips will be available to purchase at face value during the 5-Stand event and at the Dinner in Pawhuska. ⚠ IMPORTANT TRAVEL NOTICES

- **CELL SERVICE:** Service is spotty or non-existent near the destination. Please **DOWNLOAD** the map area to your phone before leaving home.
- **GPS WARNING:** Do not rely solely on GPS. It may take you to the wrong gate. Follow the written instructions below for the final turns.

FROM THE EAST (e.g., Pawhuska, OK)

- Start by heading **WEST** on **US-60 W**, towards Ponca City.
- Continue on US-60 W for approximately **13 miles**.
- Turn North on Foraker Road and travel another **13 miles North**.
- Upon approaching the Foraker intersection turn left or west and travel **1 mile**.
- After traveling 1 mile west from Foraker be looking for red gates, cattle guard, and a TCU sign located on the south side of the road.
- From the cattle guard entrance, follow the road south **1.5 miles. Arrived!**
